

What will I be learning?

In Advanced Higher Biology, you will attend Science 6 periods per week and will study the following topic areas:

- · Cells and proteins
- Organisms and evolution
- Investigative Biology

In addition to knowledge and understanding, you will develop skills and learn how to apply your knowledge to unfamiliar situations

You will also have the opportunity to carry out practical work in an assignment task assessed by the SQA

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed throughout the year. Your first test will be in September. Further tests will be after each unit. You will also have the chance to do resit tests.

You will also be doing an assignment in N5 which includes a practical investigation and write up.

Your teacher will share with you how to achieve each level with the feedback sheets and tracking interviews, so you know how to improve your result on the next task.
