In Higher, you will attend RMPS six periods per week and will study the following topic areas:

How will I be assessed?

All topics in the Higher RMPS course have a tracking activity at the end of the unit. You will also be working towards your assignment, researching a religious, moral or philosophical question of your own choice.

These tasks help you demonstrate knowledge and understanding of beliefs and practices in a major world religion, different responses to moral issues surrounding justice, and the arguments involved in the debate around a philosophical question.

Your teacher will hold regular learning conversations with you, so that you know how you are progressing and how to improve your performance.

You will also have a prelim in January followed by a second prelim once the delivery of the course is complete.



What does homework look like?

You will receive at least one piece of homework per week.

The homework for Higher RMPS includes research tasks, example exam questions, and revision.
