National 5 RMPS Course



What will I be learning?

In N5, you will attend RMPS four periods per week and will study the following topic areas:

- World Religion: Islam
- Morality and Belief:
Morality and Justice
- Religious and Philosophical
Questions: Origins
- Assignment

How will I be assessed?

All topics in the N5 RMPS course have assessment activities. There will be a tracking activity at the end of each unit. You will also be working towards your assignment, researching a religious, moral or philosophical question of your own choice.

These tasks help you demonstrate knowledge and understanding of beliefs and practices in a major world religion, different responses to moral issues surrounding justice, and the arguments involved in the debate around a philosophical question.

Your teacher will hold regular learning conversations with you, so that you know how you are progressing and how to improve your performance.

What does homework look like?

You will receive at least one piece of homework per fortnight.

The homework for National RMPS includes research tasks, example exam questions, and revision.
