What will I be learning?

In S2, you will attend RMPS two periods per week and will study the following topic areas:

- Human Rights
- Life After Death?
- Media, Technology and Morality
- Judaism, Anti-Semitism and the Holocaust
- Morality and Global Issues

How will I be assessed?

All topics in the S2 RMPS course have assessment activities. These activities are normally tasks with an element of choice in the final product displaying your learning and skills.

These tasks help you demonstrate knowledge and understanding of different beliefs, moral issues and ways of making moral decisions, analysis and evaluation of this knowledge and the ability to engage critically with sources. Your work will be graded at bronze, silver or gold level.

Your teacher will share with you how to achieve each level, so you know how to improve your result on the next task.

Don't worry if you need additional support to complete your assessments - your teacher will organise this for you!

What does homework look like?

You will receive at least one piece of homework per topic.

The homework for RMPS is in the form of research tasks, reflection tasks, source tasks and revision for in-class assessments.
