How will I be assessed?

All topics in the S3 RMPS course have assessment activities. These activities are normally tasks with an element of choice in the final product displaying your learning and skills. You will also be working towards building up evidence that forms part of the SQA Scottish Studies Award and Religion, Beliefs and Values Award.

These tasks help you demonstrate knowledge and understanding of different beliefs, moral and social issues and ways of making moral decisions, analysis and evaluation of this knowledge, the ability to engage critically with sources and to plan and implement a project based on your values. Your work will be graded at bronze, silver or gold level.

Your teacher will share with you how to achieve each level, so you know how to improve your result on the next task.



What does homework look like?

You will receive at least one piece of homework per topic.

The homework for RMPS is in the form of research tasks, reflection tasks, source tasks, project work and revision for in-class assessments.
