How will I be assessed?

You will receive a closed-book written test at the end of each topic.

You will complete an S3 exam in March. You will then sit an extended test in October, and a prelim in December as part of the whole school prelim diet. The prelim paper covers the full course.

An open-book course assignment is completed over 8 hours of consecutive class time in February and is worth 20% of your overall mark. This is marked externally by the SQA.

N4 pupils will complete unit assessments for Physical, Human and Global Issues and complete an AVU coursework.



What does homework look like?

You are expected to complete ongoing revision at home using past papers. You may also receive specific questions or online quizzes to complete as part of revision for upcoming tests.

The homework for Geography is always posted on Satchel One for you to access. All course notes can be found on the class team in the Teams app.
