N3/4/5 offered for Geography, History, Modern Studies and RMPS. At N3 and N4 level pupils are expected to complete three end of unit assessments across the course, and also an individual research project (AVU). At N5 level pupils are expected to complete an 80 mark exam lasting 2 hours 20 minutes, and also an assignment. The combined mark will determine their overall grade.
Higher offered for Geography, History, Modern Studies and RMPS. For each subject, pupils will sit two exam papers and also complete an assignment. The combined mark will determine their overall grade.

Offered in History, Modern Studies and RMPS. Pupils will be expected to complete a three hour exam and a 4000-5000 word dissertation in History and Modern Studies/ 3000-4000 word dissertation in RMPS.

Pupils complete three units from across the curriculum with a Scottish focus: Tourism in Scotland, Social Inequality and Physical Geography. Pupils also have to complete an individual research project for the Scotland in Focus unit. Assessment is ongoing throughout the course instead of a final exam.

Pupils complete four units: Employability, Customer Service, Tourism in Scotland, and Tourism in the UK and Worldwide. Pupils will develop skills for life learning and work. Assessment is ongoing throughout the course instead of a final exam.

Pupils will complete this course through the Humanities and Science Faculties. They will complete the mandatory Crime in the Community unit, as well as two other units e.g. History of Criminology, Forensic Science, and Crime Scenes. Assessment is ongoing throughout the course instead of a final exam.



Humanities Faculty S3-S4 Courses



S3

Geography

All subjects will complete the Scottish context unit for N3/4/5 which will also count towards a Level 4 or 5 award in Scottish Studies.

History

All subjects will complete a Scotland in Focus assignment which will act as a practise N4/5 AVU/assignment and will also count towards a Level 4 or 5 award in Scottish Studies.

Modern Studies

Through core RMPS pupils will complete the 'Values in Action' unit of the RBV award.

RMPS

S4

All subjects will complete the other two units needed for N3/4/5. Those presented for N3 or N4 will be expected to complete three unit assessments. Those presented for N5 will be expected to sit an 80 mark exam paper lasting 2 hours 20 minutes.

All subjects will complete an AVU (N4) or assignment (N5). The N5 assignment is worth 20% of the overall grade and is completed under timed conditions.

Through core RMPS pupils will complete the 'Investigating Religion and Belief' unit of the RBV award.
